

and manufacturing of various aircraft platforms. President Murmu com-

plimented ISRO for its sincere efforts and contribution toward making India

the sixth country in the world to have cryogenic manufacturing capabilities.

"HAL and ISRO together contribute to strategic defence and development. The glorious past of HAL and ISRO gives us an assurance that these organisations will continue to play a significant and positive role in the future as India enters the Amrit Kaal," President Murmu added.

Virology institute to come up in Bengaluru President Murmu also laid the foundation stone for the Zonal Institute of Virology (South zone) through video-conferencing.

"Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) provided exemplary support for effective COVID-19 management and is expanding its research infrastructure," President Mur-

mu said.

National Institute of Virology, Pune, under the Indian Council of Medical Research, is taking all possible steps to increase R&D in the field of virology. The National Institute of Virology has been designated as one of the collaborating laboratories of the World Health Organisation, President Murmu said. "The expansion of National Institute of Virology through zonal campuses across the country, to cater to the demand in the various regions, is praiseworthy," she said.
